Guidelines for you to help us...

- 1. Because of small cubby space, please bring your child's belongings in a small diaper bag or tote.
- 2. Include these items in your bag: diapers, wipes, a change of clothing, pacifier, bottle, sippy cup, or anything else needed to make your baby more comfortable
- 3. Please do not include: personal toys from home, medicine of any kind. (If your child needs medication, it must be administered by the parents), your personal items such as keys, wallet, cell phones, etc.
- 4. Label your child's personal items with either a tag or a permanent marker.
- 5. When dropping off your child at the nursery, it is important that you fill out the "Fast Pass" completely. Don't forget to list allergies and diapering/restroom requests.

Safety Policies...Listed below are the policies and procedures for the Sunbeam Nursery. These policies provide the foundation for our structure and are in place for the health and safety of your child.

- 1. You will be given a sticker that has an identification number on it which matches a sticker attached to your child. At the end of the service, your child will only be released to the person carrying that sticker. (Driver's license ID will also be permitted)
- 2. If your child is upset and we are unable to console him/her. You will be contacted and asked to come to comfort them.
- 3. Babies will only be fed from their own bottles or sippy cups. Water will be available. Toddlers will be given snacks from the "Fast Pass" list. Please indicate if there is any snacks you do not want them to have. You are welcome to come in to feed your baby or use the Mother's room if needed.
- 4. Sick Child Policy: Please do not bring your child to the nursery if they present any of the following conditions: persistent coughing and/or sneezing, discolored nasal discharge, vomiting (within the last 48 hours), diarrhea (within the last 48 hours), symptoms of pink-eye and contagious rashes.
- 5. No one will be allowed beyond the Nursery door except scheduled Nursery Caregivers and those comforting their own children.
- 6. In the event of a necessary evacuation your child will be safely transported outside the building and supervised until you arrive.

General information...

- 1. Every adult nursery caregiver goes through an extensive background check.
- 2. Adult caregivers are trained on the policies and procedures as well and have been approved as caregivers for young children.
